

# GLADSTONE PRIMARY SCHOOL

## 2: HOME LEARNING

### RATIONALE

Regular home learning is a valuable aspect of the learning process which connects the home with the school teaching environment and gives students opportunities to practise and reinforce the learning taking place at school.

### GUIDELINES

1. Each child will be assigned home learning on a regular basis according to age and learning needs.
2. Home Learning will be related to classroom work and used to reinforce it. In Year 1 home learning will be the daily reader, high frequency words, basic facts.

Year 2 – daily reading, basic facts, high frequency words

Year 3-6 – daily reading, basic facts/tables, spelling words and when necessary the completion of work from the teaching programme

3. No worksheets are to be given for home learning unless they are related to the basic facts/time tables and/or the current spelling words.
4. Teachers will be responsible for giving feedback on each child's homework where applicable.

### PROCEDURE:

- The expectation of home learning in each mini school will be communicated to parents during the first month of the school year; e.g. Home Learning Book, reading, spelling, tables, basic facts.
