The class teacher will store excess stationery which will be distributed as required.

Please buy:

Note that the Warwick is our preferred brand as the quality is better, there are more pages and the staples are stronger.

- 2 x Whiteboard pens (2 x black bullet and 2 x blue bullet)
- 1 x Ruler plastic, 30cm (no bendy rulers please)
- 2 x Red ball point pens (preferably "Bic")
- 2 x Highlighter pens (one yellow and one green)
- 1 x Scrapbook with blank pages (Clever Kiwi brand, for Topic & Health)
- 2 x ILA4 Exercise books with 9mm lines (Warwick code 2803755, Writing)
- 2 x 1WB Exercise books for literacy (Warwick code 2804581, Reading & Te Reo)
- 1 x 3B1 notebook for spelling (Warwick code 2204134, Homework)
- Book Bag - You may re-use last year's book bag. However, if you are purchasing a new book bag please buy the "large" A3 size to accommodate library books.

Please Note:

- There are specialist books required by the year 3 children that are not available through regular stationers. They are a maths book, a handwriting book and a reading logbook. They will be provided by the school.
- The school will also provide all the pencils and glue sticks to use during the year.
- By bulk buying these items we can obtain top quality items at a very economical price.
- The cost for all the above items totals \$18 per child for the year.
- **The \$18 is listed on the School Donation/Fees form. It is compulsory to pay this. It can be paid online on the Edge: <https://parent.edgelearning.co.nz>**
- However if your child commences during the school year i.e. after 9 February the \$18 is included in the "New Student Charge" of \$70.
